



**“DUMMY DOWNHILL” RULES & REGULATIONS**  
**Saturday, February 9th at 2 pm**

- Maximum weight is 50 lbs (22 kgs)
- Maximum height is 48 inches (120 cms)
- Minimum height 24 inches (60cms)
- No humans or animals can be included as part of the entry.
- No pyrotechnics, fire, smoke or motorized parts.
- Devices to hold snow or extra weight are not permitted.
- All Down Hill Dummies must be mounted to either 1 snowboard or 2 skis.
- No sleds or toboggans may be used.
- For safety reasons, metal bracing or metal weights may not be used in dummies.
- The Dummy can not have any glass, ceramic, or sharp metal objects.
- Acceptable construction materials include wood, plastic, wire, tape, foam rubber, vinyl, cardboard or plastic tubing.
- Weight and ballast can be provided with sand or other non-hazardous materials.
- No weights can be added at the top of the course.
- Only one person may be at the top of the course to launch the dummy. If a small child is going to launch the dummy they must be accompanied by an adult.
- After the race, it is the responsibility of the owner to remove and dispose of their dummy.

**Judging**

All entries must be ready for judging by noon on Sat. 2/9 and must be judged outside the Summit Lodge. Once they are judged and inspected they will be on display in front of the Summit Lodge until the competition starts. \$10 entry fee must be paid upon inspection. (Benefits Big Brothers/Big Sisters of Blair County)

Points will be awarded for:

- o Creativity
- o Durability or survival of the competition track
- o Airtime
- o Distance

Honorable mention will be given to the best carnage!
